

Awarding of Grant – Rolling Three-year Cycle

- Grants are calculated on a three-year cycle.
- The grant values of the applicant's previous two years are considered in determining the eligible amount of the grant in the third year.
- An applicant cannot receive more than a total of \$50,000 over three years.

Grant Eligibility: \$50,000 over three yrs.
